
Setting up MPE Envelope



STEP 1

Choose the right version

If you use Live 11, we recommend using the Live 11 version.

Presets saved in the Live 11 version can be opened in the standard version, and vice-versa. So if you end up upgrading to Live 12 or later, you'll be able to safely transfer all your presets over.

The only difference between these two versions is the default value for the Modulation Type parameter. In the Live 11 version, it defaults to 'remote mode'. The alternative mode was introduced in Live 12, and does not function in Live 11. While the standard version works fine in Live 11, users would need to manually change the Modulation Type parameter for each mapping.

To open Live 11 version presets in the standard version, simply replace the Live 11 version's .amxd file with the standard version's .amxd file inside of Ableton's browser. Additionally, the Live 11 version will function perfectly fine in Live 12.

STEP 2

Make MPE Envelope discoverable in Ableton Live's Browser

OPTION 1:

Adding the MPE Envelope.amxd file to your User Library

- 1. Download and unzip the "MPE Envelope" download folder
- 2. Inside of Live 12, open the browser.
- 3. Drag the MPE Envelope.amxd file from its unzipped folder, and drop it into the "User Library" folder under the "Places" category. Optionally, you can place it in a subfolder of your choosing.

OPTION 2:

Installing the Live Pack file

- 1. Download and unzip the "MPE Envelope" folder
- 2. If you don't already have one, create a folder on your computer or external hard drive for third-party packs. We recommend naming the folder "Third-Party Packs".
- 3. To install the pack, double click the .alp file or drag it into Live.
- 4. Live will ask you where to install it. Choose the "Third-Party Packs" folder that you created.
- 5. On the bottom left side of Ableton's Browser, click "Add Folder..."
- 6. Add the "Third-Party Packs" Folder.
